Residing in rural Kakamega and serving in Kenya West has broadened our understanding of life in developing countries. We have adjusted to the road traffic now, with hundreds of boda-bodas (motorcycles), three-wheeled tuk-tuks (mini-cars), and matatus (small vans) that control the roads as taxis. Morris is brave enough to drive, but I choose not to.

Kenyans are warm and friendly and make us feel welcome. They love to feed you – just like Newfoundlanders! We enjoy some of the local cuisine, while some dishes we graciously consume to show respect. The working language is English, but they naturally love to use their native tongue, Swahili. The people are quite happy when our morning greeting is "Habari asubuhi." And of course, worship for us now includes lots of upbeat singing and dancing – yes we join in. We love the occasions that connect us with youth and children, so we jump at any opportunity for school visits or seeing youth in divisional gatherings.
